Role Description

The clear role of the Choral Scholar is as a singer. Choral Scholars play a fundamental role in the Cathedral's mission and ministry, and as such are a valued part of the team of those that worship at the Ballarat Anglican Cathedral.

The Choral Scholarship is both a learning role and a support role. A stipend is offered to support the Scholar in her or his development.

The Scholar will effectively act as Section lead (for the Soprano, Alto, Tenor or Bass sections) and will be trained as a Cantor for some of the Sunday morning Choral Eucharist services (taking turns with other Cantors from the choir).

Further training will be offered in music selection, management of a music library, choir management and conducting (depending on the personal goals of the Scholar).
